

ELECTRIC ANIMISM AND A HUMBLE ATHEIST

Thursday | 16 May | 8pm

Electric Animism and a Humble Atheist is a sound and movingimage show featuring intersections of the creative practices of Dharma (in music) and Hun Ping (in film). In the course of this collaboration, they imagine alternate realities in the world around us, and explore overlapping notions in the spectrum of devotional, spiritual and theoretical beliefs which inform their individual practices.

The performance will showcase music from Dharma's latest album *Electric Animism* together with Hun Ping's recent film *Dance of a Humble Atheist* and reconstructions of his past experimental films.
